The newly re-organised site houses dedicated manufacturing cells for all product lines, together with a customer showroom allowing the exhibiting of all 600 UK products. This is complemented by new offices for all 600 UK sales, support and head office staff.

Showing for the first time were Colchester new 2 and 3-axis Tornado CNC Turning Centres, alongside its market leading Colchester and Harrison centre and Alpha CNC combination lathe ranges. The new Tornado is built using a modular design, which provides a most robust manufacturing platform, ensuring greater accuracy and reliability, giving CNC lathe operators even more value for money.

Visitors also saw the launch of Pratt Burnerd Internationals new £ripfastqCombination Power Chuck, which provides CNC lathe customers with a chuck, a collet chuck and a mandrel chuck all combined in the one unit, allowing instant set-up changes for medium to small batch production runs, increasing productivity and minimizing non-

machining time.
